Stanbridge Lower School PTFA feel that we were able to have a very positive impact on school life for the 2018/19 academic year which has resulted in funding for various projects and events.

- The summer BBQ and fete following Sports Day last summer was very successful and we thank everyone for their support. A total of £1177.60 was raised.
