History

A Local History Study – Children will take a look at the village of Stanbridge during Victorian times. What was it like? What will we discover?

Geography

Hills and Mountains – Children will start by looking at higher ground across the UK. Where Are the Hills and Mountains? Show children a map of the UK. Do you know any areas of hills or mountains? Where do you think they might be? Look at the topographical map. What do the different colours tell you? Where are the highest areas of land? Where are the lowest areas?

Identify higher ground local to us and investigate. Discuss Chiltern Hills and what it is like.

Rivers – Children will follow the journey of a river, identifying along the way the different landscapes that a river might pass through. We will learn geographical vocabulary by learning key rivers terms.

Rocks - children will discover the different types of rocks and how they are formed. Children will compare and group rocks based on appearance and simple properties. They will learn how fossils are formed and learn about the contribution of Mary Anning to the field of palaeontology. Children will understand how soil is formed and then investigate the permeability of different types of soil. We will then take a look at somewhere local we can discover some rocks and fossils ourselves.
