



As part of our continuing programme to reach as many communities as possible and give them the opportunity to have their vaccination, the NHS has arranged two COVID-19 vaccination clinics to be held on 26 and 27 May. This is aimed specifically at the Gypsy, Roma and Traveller community as a way to make sure these communities are protected.

Full risk assessments have been carried out to ensure that, as with all clinics, cleaning regimes are strictly adhered to. In addition, infection control precautions will be maintained by all vaccination staff, at all times and for all patients. The entrance to the clinic is separate to the children's exit from the school and marshals will be in place to ensure smooth parking arrangements.

As I am sure you appreciate, the School is a location that people are comfortable attending and we want to use these clinics to encourage as many people as possible to have the vaccine.
