## Uniform Policy

### 1. INTRODUCTION

StanbridgeLower School recognises the importance of creating a shared identity for the school. We aim to foster a pride in both the appearance of individual pupils, and the school as a whole, through the wearing of a school uniform. Our uniform also aids easy identification of Stanbridge children when they are outside the school, helping to ensure their safety.

### 2. PRINCIPLES

2.1 This Uniform Policy is underpinned by the following principles:

- That the children wear uniform when at school.
- That the uniform be comfortable and practical for the children to wear throughout the year and enables children to choose types of clothing they feel most comfortable in.
- That the uniform be smart.
- That the uniform be widely available in a range of high street stores to ensure it is competitively priced so preventing social exclusion.
- That where items are available to purchase from the school this is not a requirement.

### 3. UNIFORM

PE Uniform
<i>Black/Navy shorts.</i> <i>White T-shirt.</i> <i>Plimsolls or trainers.</i> <i>Winter: Warm tracksuit/top (any colour)</i> <i>A bag in which to store the PE uniform on the child's peg.</i>

### 4. OTHER INFORMATION

4.1 Long hair: please ensure this is tied back where possible for safety reasons.

4.2 Jewellery and watches:

- Religious Jewellery may be worn and kept inside clothing for safety. If this can't be removed when taking part in PE/Sport, please talk to your class teacher.
- Studs earrings can be worn and the child must be able to remove these for PE/Sport lessons. If you are considering having your child's ears pierced re recommend this being done over the summer holidays.
- Watches/fitness trackers may be worn. Smart watches: all video and voice recording devices on the smart watches must be deactivated due to safeguarding and GDPR regulations.

4.3 Book bags may be purchased from the school office.

## **5. PRE-LOVED UNIFORM**

5.1 We hold a selection of pre-loved uniform that parents have donated to the school and this is available to all parents on request. Please speak to Mrs Davies the Family Liaison Officer or contact the school office if you would like to select items for your child.

5.2 We ask all parents to consider passing on uniform to other families when their child leaves Stanbridge either directly or through donating good quality items to school for our pre-loved uniform box.
