
PTFA Bag2School collection - 12th October 2023

This is the 4th year at Stanbridge Lower School we have organised a Bag2School clothes collection and it's a really easy way to raise funds for the school. Quite simply the more we collect, the more we raise! Please see the leaflet attached and in book bags on what can be collected. Drop your bags off in the playground on 12th October by 9am and they do the rest!



Bag2School is the UK's leading textile recycler and fundraiser working with schools and since its inception in 2001 it has now paid out over £36 million.

As well as raising vitally needed funds for schools, it also helps the environment by helping to divert unwanted textiles away from landfill. A recent DEFRA report has shown that textile collection schemes are helping to reduce the volume of textiles discarded as municipal solid waste. However it is a fact that as a nation we still send 350,000 tonnes of textiles to landfill every year.

By getting involved in our **Bag2School** collection, you have an opportunity to sort through your cupboards and wardrobes and donate unwanted textiles – this can include adults' and children's clothes, shoes (tied together please), hats, belts, handbags, (please refer to http://uk.bag2school.com/ for full details). In addition to raising much needed funds it will also raise awareness amongst the children of the benefits of recycling and reuse.
