Grand Finale: A Superhero Day to showcase everything we have learnt about ourselves. During this day, we will have a class talent show where we can show special talents or pieces of work from across the half-term.

Geography:

Topic: Our Local Area

In Geography, the children will be –

- Making observations about the school grounds and Stanbridge
- Beginning to identify human and physical features
- Studying aerial photographs of our local area
- Finding the UK and Stanbridge on a map

Physical Education:

Topic: Running, Jumping, Throwing and Catching

In PE, the children will be –

- Learning different throwing techniques including underarm
- Practising catching objects including balls
- Learning how to run for speed and distance
- Jumping and moving in different ways

Science:

Topic: Everyday Materials + Seasonal Changes

In Science, the children will be –

- Identifying and naming materials
- Describing the properties of materials
- Performing simple tests to compare materials and their properties
- Observe changes across seasons – Autumn focus

History:

Topic: Significant People

In History, the children will be –

- Recognising the difference between past, present and future
- Creating a timeline of their own lives
- Recognising what it means to be a significant person
- Finding out about Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole

RE:

Topic: What do Christians believe God is like?

In RE, the children will be –

- Exploring what Christians believe about God
- Looking at what a parable is
- Learning how to show forgiveness

PSHCE:

Topic: Health and Wellbeing Part 1

In PSHCE, the children will be –

- Learning how to keep themselves healthy including diet and dental hygiene
- Identifying feelings and finding ways to manage them
- Setting simple goals

Music:

Topic: All About Me

In Music, the children will be –

- Listening to and repeating short rhythmic patterns
- Maintaining the pulse using body percussion and untuned instruments
- Using voices expressively including singing

Art:

Topic: Printing + 3D Form

In Art, the children will be –

- Printing using objects, vegetables and sponges
- Making a printing block using cardboard and string
- Creating texture in playdough and clay using tools
- Designing, making and evaluating their own superhero logo

Computing:

Topic: Self-image and Identity + Managing Online Information

In Computing, the children will be –

- Discussing scenarios and how to respond to them
- Deciding whether websites are real or make believe
- Learning how to keep safe when accessing the internet
