At Stanbridge, our aim is to develop confident, fluent readers who love books. We are having a big push on reading to support this, so please don't be alarmed if your child says they are having extra phonics or reading sessions. One of the best ways to get better is practice; the more we read, the better we get - we need your support with this too. Please read with your child at least three times a week; this could include them reading to you, you reading to them or reading together. If you are worried about your child's reading progress, please speak with your child's teacher.

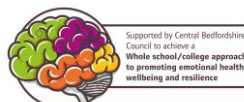
School Uniform, PE Kit & Winter Coats

Children should also have PE kits in school on their PE days: black shorts or jogging bottoms, a white t-shirt and trainers. There is no longer an option to borrow kit, but if you need support with organising a PE kit, please speak with Mrs Davies.



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As the cold weather continues, please ensure you send your child with a winter coat, hat and gloves. The children will continue to go outside for break and lunch and an anorak will no longer suffice.

Homework Changes for Yr2,3,4

As explained before Christmas, we will be trialling a new homework approach for Yr2,3,4. This will be online and offer a more targeted and supportive set of tasks. A letter with your child's username, password and instructions of how to log on will be coming home tomorrow and we will begin using this platform from Friday 12th January. A big thankyou to Mrs Brewer who has led on this new initiative. We will continue to review how well this works and look forward to feedback at the next Parent Forum.

New Policies

The school's behaviour and anti-bullying policies have been reviewed and are available on the school website under the policies tab. Creating a culture that promotes excellent behaviour is important to us and although behaviour at Stanbridge is generally good, we want to ensure that all pupils can learn in a calm, safe, and supportive environment. Our new behaviour policy outlines our expectations underpinned by our values, attitudes, and beliefs. It is an important way to communicate the school culture to pupils, staff, parents and carers. Staff have spent time exploring the policy as part of their training and children have been introduced to the new policy during assemblies. Please do take time to read them too.

Curriculum Events

We will be hosting several curriculum events this term and these are highlighted in the diary dates at the end of this letter. A new event for Stanbridge will be the introduction of the Symbols of Faith week, where each year group will learn about a different faith, representing their learning through RE, Design & Technology and writing. More details will follow shortly, as we would love to invite parents to share in this event.

I continue to receive leave requests for holidays. Holidays in term time will not be agreed. It is important that your child is in school every day to support learning, as well as wellbeing. 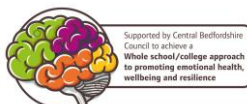
We look forward to seeing you at some of our events this term.
