Pirates!

Simmering Starter: The children will create their own pirate name and make pirate hats!

Grand Finale: The children will be making their own telescopes and going on a treasure hunt around the school grounds!

Physical Education:

Topic: Athletics (bat and ball)

In PE, the children will be –

- Developing balance and co-ordination when holding a racket and hitting a ball or beanbag
- Applying racket skills to a target game
- Using a cricket bat to control a ball along the ground
- Using a cricket bat to hit a ball with control

PSHCE:

Topic: Living in the Wider World + Zones of Regulation

In PSHCE, the children will be –

- Explaining how to care for themselves and others
- Learning about different groups and the roles within those groups
- Finding ways to care for the environments
- Learning about the Zones of Regulation and ways to support their feelings

Science:

Topic: Animals, including Humans – Part 2

In Science, the children will be –

- Identifying and naming a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
- Grouping and comparing a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals including pets)

History:

Topic: Famous Pirates

In History, the children will be –

- Finding out about pirates and the role they played in history
- Researching the different job roles that pirates had
- Learning about famous pirates such as Black Beard and Anne Bonney

Forest School:

In Forest School, the children will be –

- Identifying different types of butterflies
- Finding ways to care for butterflies (feeders and flowers)
- Learning about the parts of butterflies
- Understanding the lifecycle of a butterfly

Geography:

Topic:

In Geography, the children will be –

- Locating and naming the five oceans
- Comparing human and physical features of the Caribbean to Leighton Buzzard
- Using positional and directional language such as North, South, East and West

Music:

Topic: Under the Sea

In Music, the children will be –

- Making movements that are appropriate to the pulse and tempo of a piece of music
- Choosing instruments to represent ocean animals
- Creating pitches and rhythms
- Learning key vocabulary such as dynamics, tempo, pulse and pitch

Art:

Topic: Weaving and Textiles

In Art, the children will be –

- Learning how to weave paper
- Creating a weaved sea creature
- Using different types of textiles to make a 3D 'Under the Sea' themed collage

Computing:

Topic: Online Reputation and Health + Wellbeing(E-Safety)

In Computing, the children will be –

- Recognising that information can stay online and could be copied
- Explaining rules themselves safe when using technology at home and in school
